## **Milwaukee Lakefront Marathon Pasta Dinner Buffet Hosted by American Cancer Society DetermiNation™ Athlete Program**

*Madison, WI native and 22-year cancer survivor, Darren Fortney, has motivated runners, athletes, and others across the country over seven years. Most recently, Darren competed in the 32nd Badwater Ultramarathon. This legendary event pitted 90 of the world's toughest athletes against one another and the elements. Covering 135 miles non-stop from Death Valley to Mt. Whitney, CA in temperatures up to 130°F, it is the most demanding and extreme running race offered anywhere on the planet. The Badwater course covers three mountain ranges for a total of 13,000' of cumulative vertical ascent and 4,700' of cumulative descent.*

*In addition to being a cancer survivor, Darren also overcame complications from a major back/spinal cord accident in 2003 that resulted in surgeons telling him that he may never walk again. Having permanently lost much of the feeling in his left leg, both calves, and the tops of both feet, Darren went on a quest to not only walk again, but to rebuild his body and begin to live a healthier lifestyle. Prior to going out for the first run of his life (literally a run around the block), Darren did not swim, bike, or run and weighed over 220 lbs.*

*Since that run around the block, Darren has competed in 3 Ironmans, over 30 triathlons (Sprint, Olympic & Half Ironman distances), 8 marathons, 3 ultra-swims across Lake Mendota (6+ miles each), 4- 100 mile ultra-marathons and the Badwater Ultramarathon. Throughout his athletic achievements, Darren has helped to raise over \$32,000 for the UW Comprehensive Cancer Center and Gilda's Club in Madison. He is also a dedicated cancer organization advocate and volunteer and is the proud father of 10 year old Ryan and 8 year old Lauren.*
